

On November 5th, Dr. Jessica Li, the Chair of the Review Panel announced the result of the 2020 Jiang-Wang-Land Outstanding Student Paper Award. Miss Serena (Yunran) Zhang from the Chinese University of Hong Kong received the 2020 Jiang-Wang-Land Outstanding Student Paper Award.

Serena's paper, *Control, peer effects, and normalization of recreational drug use in China: Gender as a moderator,* stood out above all the high quality submitted papers. The Award Review Panel (Professors Nicole Cheng, Shanhe Jiang, Ivan Sun, and Kevin Wang) highly commended her paper. Thanks also to Eddie Wei and Iris Luo for their assistance.

On November 19th, ACCCJ hosted a special and prestigious award presentation from Hong Kong, via ZOOM. 10-year celebration status

Association of Chinese Criminology and Criminal Justice (ACCCJ) was officially established on November 17, 2010 in San Francisco. A total of 32 scholars from Canada, mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan, the U.K., and the U.S. attended the inaugural meeting during which the draft bylaws of the association was discussed and a board of directors were elected. Seven members were elected to serve the first board, including President Liqun Cao, President-elect Shanhe Jiang, Treasurer Bin Liang, and directors Xiaogang Deng, Bill Hebenton, and Hong Lu and Ivan Sun. The total number grew to over 50 during the 2010 ASC meeting!
