

## **ACCCJ Annual Report of 2021-2022**

Dear members of ACCCJ,

On behalf of the 2021-2022 Board of Directors, it is my honor and pleasure to highlight activities of our association in the past year.

**1. 2021-2022 Board of Director and Meetings**: following the election in 2021, the new Board consists of the following members: Bin Liang (President), Hong Lu (President-elect), Luye Li (Treasurer), and Shing (Vincent) Cheng, Bo Jiang, Kai Lin, and Xiaoshuang (Iris) Luo (board directors). I'd like to express my gratitude to all board directors for their diligent work in the past year!

Several formal and informal meetings were held via Zoom as follows:
